Eligibility Criteria

Requests can be accepted from registered Canadian not for profit organizations.

Requests will not be accepted from:

- Academic Institutions
- Hospitals
- Medical Societies
- Professional Associations
- CPD providers
- Individuals
- Private clinics
- For profit organizations
- Medical education agencies/vendors

Exclusionary Criteria

Ineligible expenses may include but are not limited to:

- Unrestricted funds
- Scholarships to individuals
- Organizations that do not have a valid non-profit, tax-exempt status
- Loans
- Trips or tours
- Sectarian and religious organizations that do not serve the general public on a nondenominational basis
- Operating expenses (to support existing costs associated with salaries, equipment, textbooks or subscriptions to publications, online meeting platforms, website development, phone lines).
- Capital requests (building funds, endowments, multi-year commitments) are generally not supported unless part of a broader healthcare or science education project that has meaningful community impact
- Political groups
- Advocacy or lobbying activities directed towards any specific legislation
- Organizations whose missions/objectives do not meet our contributions guidelines
- Donations to individuals or to a charity on behalf of a customer
- Educational grants/research grants
- Commercial Co-Ventures (CCV)
- Contests or tournaments
